The Student Tuition Assistance Relationship (STAR) Program matches students in need of tuition assistance with a generous donor - a STAR who contributes tuition assistance of \$3,000 a year.

Tuition varies across our network of 35 Catholic elementary schools, and this program is intended to fund nearly half of the student's tuition and that any monies left over from the contribution will be placed in our Tuition Assistance Fund. The current average tuition for the first child is over \$7,700. The parent/quardian contributed the remainder of the tuition. THF's STAR students demonstrate the highest need among our applicants.
